FUTURE WORLD CHANGER NAMED

LUIS MANRIQUEZ OF DENVER NAMED GAMESTOP YOUTH GRANT WINNER

Denver, CO: April 18, 2007 – Today, Do Something named Luis Manriquez, as a 2007 GameStop Youth Grant winner. Luis hails from Denver, CO, and was awarded the grant for founding Denver Biodiesel, an organization that distributes biodiesel and educates the public on its positive environmental effects. Denver Biodiesel is a cooperative business run by volunteers that has distributed over 10,000 gallons of biodiesel and has taught high school classes on the topic.

Every week, starting in February, Do Something will identify a promising young leader who has a great idea and needs a little support to grow that dream into reality. The winners, age 25 and under from the U.S. and Canada, will be chosen based on the potential of their project to greatly improve the local community or a community abroad. One previous winner of the GameStop Youth Grant used her grant to generate a literary journal produced by and for incarcerated youth. Another awardee used his grant to create a locally-run farm that grows healthy food for the poor, neighboring community.

"Our partnership with Do Something is a unique effort to advance volunteerism and support the unique perspectives that young people can bring to addressing issues in their own community," indicated Chris Olivera, Vice President , Corporate Communications of GameStop Corp.
